League Rules

- Utica Curling Club Mixed Doubles Rules will apply.
- Games are 8 ends. *Choice and stone colors are assigned.*
- If tied after 8 ends, extra ends will be played to determine the winner.
- Teams must play at least 6 ends to constitute an official game.
- Teams must field at least one original member of team or forfeit game.
- Teams are encouraged to make up games ahead of the scheduled time when practical. Teams requesting a postponement must arrange for a makeup game prior to the end of the round-robin schedule. Please do not carry more than one postponement at a time. Games not made up will be recorded as a loss for the postponing team.
- Teams will play a round robin schedule with assigned choice and rock colors
 - A two-way tie for first place will be played off. In the event more than one team is tied for first place, head-to-head results will be used recursively, if conclusive, to determine a sole champion, otherwise co-champions will be declared.
- Placement tiebreakers: In the event of a placement tie, head-to-head W-L results will be used recursively as tiebreak; if placement is still tied, W-L results against teams with better records will be considered, then head-to head (recursively) among teams still tied; if still tied, W-L results against same group of teams minus the lowest ranking team, etc. until tie is broken; if still tied, W-L results against the teams with worse records will be considered, then head-to-head (recursively) among teams still tied; If still tied, W-L results against same group of teams minus the lowest ranking team, etc. until tie is broken; if still tied, a coin flip will determine placement of tied teams.
- Bottom 4 teams will be relegated for the next league, but may re-enter if league is not filled, in order of finish. Priority to league entrance goes to teams with the most players who have not played in the previous league.
